Entering politics in 2002, Angie spent two terms in the Colorado House of Representatives, rising to become House Majority Caucus Chair. She has been a popular keynote and motivational speaker around the country, speaking on diversity, biracial and women's issues. After briefly launching a second Congressional campaign in 2007, Paccione stepped out of the race to join Pathways to Leadership Inc.
