**Natalie Sayer** joined our facilitator team in January 2007 and hails from Surprise, Arizona.

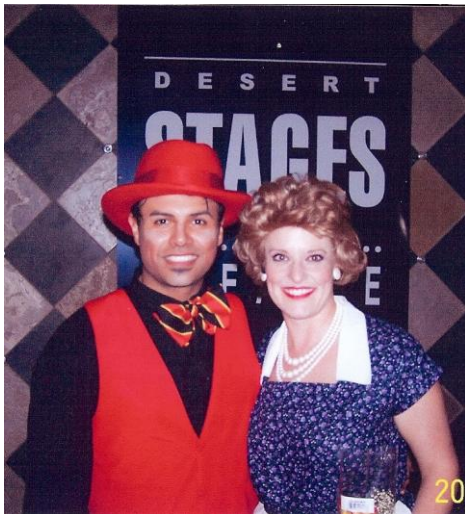
